As part of the on-site assessment, department employees and members of the community are also invited to offer comments at a public information session Tuesday April 4th, 2017 at 7:00 pm. The session will be conducted in the Schererville Town Hall located at 10 E. Joliet St. Schererville Indiana 46375.

Telephone comments, as well as, appearances at the public information session are limited to 10 minutes and must address the department's ability to comply with CALEA's standards.
