Ordinance of the Week:

Sec. 8-81 Four (4) Way Stop Signs.

When stop signs are erected upon all four streets at any intersection designated in the Town's "Traffic Control Devices", every vehicle shall stop at every sign or at a clearly marked stop line before entering the intersection. The first vehicle reaching an Intersection shall, after stopping, have the right-of-way to proceed.

(*Schererville Town Code, § 8-2-29*)



Burglary Prevention Tips

- 1 Install **motion lights** around your residence.
- 2 **Stop mail delivery** to your home and request an extra watch from your nearest police station.
- 3 **Identify** all electronics in your home by copying the serial number and model number. If a burglary occurs you can report the numbers to law enforcement. **Photograph** the items for added protection, including jewelry.
- 4 **Don't post** your vacation plans or photos on social media while you are away from your residence.
- 5 Consider joining or starting a **Neighborhood Watch** group in your area.
- 6 Consider installing an **alarm system** or camera monitoring system.
- 7 Install **deadbolts** on your front and back doors.
