LOCK IT UP

Store firearms, unloaded, in a secured cabinet, safe or case. Closets, drawers and shoeboxes are NOT safe locations.

DO NOT KEEP IT IN YOUR CAR

Firearms kept in vehicles are often stolen and used in other crimes. Do NOT leave your gun in your car.



LOCK IT AGAIN

Secure unloaded firearms with a firearm locking device or alarm to make them inoperable.

KEEP THEM SEPARATE

Keep ammunition in a separate secured storage location.

* **CRIMINAL MISCHIEF** – Pine Island Terrace – Officers made contact was made with the R/P who advised that at approximately 3:00pm on 04/20/2023, an unknown party attempted to break into the coin operated laundry machine inside the apartment building. The R/P advised the suspect was unable to gain entry to the coin repository. The R/P showed me the machine, which appeared to have been struck several times with a hammer and was heavily dented.

* **SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT** – Buttercup St. Report of kids ding dong ditching in the area. One of the parents saw the juveniles run into a home on Wildrose Ln. I then made contact with the homeowner at the residence and advised him of the complaint. He advised he would handle the issue and there would be no more issues.

* **ILLEGAL DUMPING** – Janice Dr., I responded to the listed address in regards to two white male subject that dumped garbage on the property. I spoke with the Complainant. She advised that two white males, approximately 18-21 YOA arrived in the parking lot at approximately 07:00 PM. She advised they were in a newer model Blue Ford Mustang that had a black racing strip down the middle. She reported they then loaded up a box with garbage from the vehicle, and dumber it near the wood line.

* **JUVENILE PROBLEM** – Clover Ln., Officers responded to the area of Clover Ln for a report of a group of juveniles walking around, banging on the windows of housing and knocking over trash cans. Officers arrived on scene and observed the group near Clover Ln and Rhett Ct. Once spotted by the juveniles, they took off running through the neighborhood. Officers attempted to locate the juveniles with negative results. Officers checked the area and then cleared from the scene without incident.

Ordinance of the Week:

Sec. 5-22 Hours of Operation.

The hours of operation for use of park lands and facilities designated as open to the public shall be from 6:00 a.m. to dusk daily, except those activities, programs, and events previously authorized.
