ITEM B. Police Chief



The Criminal Investigation Division filed a total of sixty-three (63) criminal charges during October, 2018.


The Monthly Crime Analysis for October, 2018 reports there were five (5) thefts from vehicles, two (2) burglaries, and eighteen (18) thefts.
