Interim Chief Zagrocki reported that for the month of June, 2018 the Patrol Division had 1,337 calls for service, 390 traffic citations, 95 property damage (PD) accidents, 14 personal injury (PI) accidents and 92 arrests.

The Criminal Investigation Division filed a total of thirty-two (32) criminal charges during June, 2018.

The Monthly Crime Analysis for June, 2018 reports there were nine (9) thefts from vehicles, zero (0) burglaries, and thirty-seven (37) thefts.


