REGULAR PARK BOARD MEETING

The Regular Park Board Meeting of the Town of Schererville, Indiana, was called to order by President Brad Bassick at 6:00 p.m. in the Schererville Town Hall, 10 East Joliet Street, Schererville, Indiana.

THEREUPON, Approval of minutes for December 1, 2021

Mr. Skvarek made a motion to approve the minutes from the December 1, 2021 meeting, seconded by Mr. Malinowski. All in favor (3-0).

THEREUPON, Correspondence

Mr. Novacich introduced Nicole Kelly, who was appointed to the Park Board from the School Board.

Mr. Novacich said there was an event request from Cystic Fibrosis Foundation to utilize Rohrman Park on May 15. Mr. Bassick if there has been any problems with this event in the past. Mr. Novacich said no. Mr. Bassick said that the Board will address the request under any other new business.

Mr. Novacich said that he received an amended permit from the Army Corp of Engineers, stating there does need to be any mitigation work for the Pennsy Phase IV project.

ITEM B. Any other from Park Board

The Board agreed to approve the event and if the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation would like the fees waived or reduced, they are welcome to request it later.

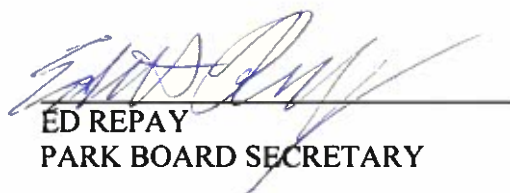
