As COVID-19 is an evolving situation, the Schererville Police Records Department will continue to take preventive measures to ensure the safety of the public and its employees.

Before coming to the Police station for Animal Tags, Incident Reports and Accident Reports contact 219- 322-5000 for available options Monday thru Friday 8am to 5pm.

F.A.Q'S

- Basic Incidents Reports - can be emailed.
- Accident Reports –may be obtained on Buycrash.com or a check can be mailed to Schererville Police Department with crash information or name of person involved.
- Animal Tags- may be mailed with a check and copy of vaccine and spay / neuter record. Your tag will be mailed or delivered back to you with your pet records.
- Tow releases – must be registered owner of the vehicle with ID and 20.00 cash.
- Gun Permits, Fingerprints, Vin Checks & Local Background checks call 219-322-5000 for appointment availability. This is to prevent overabundance of citizens at the same time in our lobby.

In the spirit of social distancing, the above is our amended procedures and may change periodically. Thank you for cooperation.
