ITEM A. Recommend Acceptance of Joint Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between the Little Calumet River Basin Development Commission and the Town of Schererville For the *SCADA Telemetry to Three Stormwater Facilities Project*.

Mr. Hansen stated that this is an interlocal agreement with the Little Calumet River Basin to install a stormwater SCADA system, which is a monitoring system for the three stormwater stations in Town. The Little Calumet River Basin will provide for 50% of the project, which is \$70,099.50 and the Town of Schererville and the Lake County Surveyor's office would split the remaining 50% cost. Mr. Hansen stated that this is something that they have been working on for a while, updating the entire SCADA system. He stated that this will be new and will help tremendously, we will be able to know in real time what the pump stations are doing.

Mr. Schmitt asked Mr. Hansen where the equipment is stored at. Mr. Hansen stated they will be right on site, one on Hartsdale, one in Stonebridge and the other one near 77<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

Mr. Schmitt made a motion to accept the Joint Interlocal Agreement between the Little Calumet River Basin Commission and the Town of Schererville, seconded by Mrs. Arvanitis. All in favor (3-0).
