BUILDING & PLANNING DEPARTMENT

PET LICENSES

Ordinance #1549 requires that all dogs and cats are to be licensed each year by the 31st of March to avoid late fees. Please take current shot record and proof of spaying/neutering to the Schererville Police Department. (No more than five (5) dogs and/or cats combined over the age of three months may be kept on any residential, commercial or other premises within the town unless the owners of the animals hold a valid permit.) Dog – **not** spayed/neutered \$30.00. Cats - **not** spayed/neutered \$30.00. Dogs/cats that are spayed/neutered are only \$10.00. Failure to obtain a license within the time period specified will result in a \$10.00 late fee as well.

CLERK-TREASURER'S OFFICE/UTILITY BILLING

The Utility Billing Department is located within the Clerk-Treasurer's Office. Utility bills include charges for water, sewer, hydrant, and trash collection. All utility bills are due by the 24th of every month. Payment can be made directly at the office during normal business hours, by mail, or left in one of 2 drop boxes. Boxes are located both in front of and behind the Town Hall. For your convenience, there is an Auto-Withdrawal Payment Plan available at no additional charge – See additional sheet attached for directions on how to sign up. Visa/MasterCard/Discover credit cards are also accepted with a fee. The stub with your name and address must accompany your payment.

Cash payment should never be left in a drop box.

VOTER REGISTRATION

You can apply at the Clerk-Treasurer's office. You may ask for a mail-in application, absentee ballot or you may complete the application and return it to county. The county voter registration office will send your approved card in the mail. Visit their website at www.indianavoters.com

APPLICATION FOR SERVICE

Customers applying for service are required to sign an Application for Service form at the Clerk Treasurer's Office and present a government issued ID. Application for service should be completed at least three days prior to needing service at a location. This practice also applies to existing customers moving to new locations within the Town of Schererville.

SUMMER SEWAGE RATE

October through April bills will reflect normal charges for sewer use. Summer brings the watering of lawns, washing of cars, and filling of swimming pools. With this water usage in mind, your water bill will reflect **discounted sewer rates for the water used from May through August.** (July, August, September and October bills).

TRASH AND RECYCLE

Please have garbage & recycling bins out by 6:00AM. Pick up for residents north of RT 30 is Wednesday and south of RT 30 is Thursday. Recycling is every other week. Please see the attached sheet for the schedule. One large item per week (furniture, etc.) will be picked up. Items containing C.F.C.'s (refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, etc) will not be picked up. Electronics are not an acceptable trash item. Pick up will be one day late for those weeks with the holidays of **New Years Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.** If you have any questions about recycling or the service that you are receiving from our waste hauler please call Republic Services at (219) 926-1046

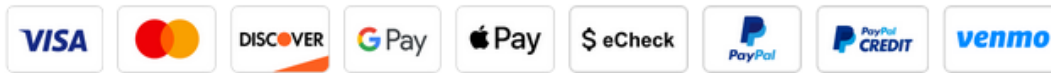

- No Late Fees-No worries of forgetting to pay the bill
 - * Payment is withdrawn automatically from your specified checking account on the due date. (24th of every month or the next business day if the 24th is a weekend or holiday)
- Hassle Free – No more writing checks – No need to call and make a payment on the phone – No stamps needed – No running to Town Hall to make a payment!
- You will receive your water bill as usual so you know what the monthly charges are. It will be marked with the following:
DIRECT WITHDRAWAL – DO NOT SEND PAYMENT
**Paperless customers will receive invoices via email until the invoice is paid on the 24th. **
- Safe and secure – Your bank information is securely maintained
- **Sign up now for Auto-Withdrawal by completing the application below, attaching a cancelled or voided check from your selected bank account and returning it to: Town of Schererville Utilities, 10 E. Joliet Street, Schererville, IN 46375**

Provisions for Auto-Withdrawal

- **Availability of Funds:** You are responsible for having enough money in the indicated account on the payment date. You will be charged the same as if a paper check “bounced” should your payment be returned with insufficient funds (\$20.00). In addition, your Auto-Withdrawal service may be cancelled if two payments are returned in a 12-month period.
- **Termination:** This authorization will remain in effect until we receive written notice from you 30 days before the cancellation date or until your final utility bill is paid.
- **Bank Account/Address Change:** You are required to notify us of any account or address changes. You are responsible for submitting a new application when a bank account or address change occurs. Failure to do so may result in a returned payment.
- **Submitting this application sets your account up for auto-withdrawal through a checking account only through our office. Do not sign up for auto-pay through Invoice Cloud (Icloud) online unless you cancel this auto-withdrawal program first.**
